





Why on Earth would Aliens talk to us?

So they could have a chat.





People can only shout to someone across the road. Aliens wouldn't find that helpful at all, or so I'm told.






SHE MAKES THE AIR THAT ALL OF US ANIMALS BREATHE!

Why would Aliens talk to us If people are mean to other Earthly beings? If we keep taking all of their land, Then they can't find a home of their own.




Like the elephants of Africa Who wander through the villages On land where elephants used to stay, And now they're forced to go away. But where are they supposed to go? They can't just fly to outer space


Before people decided to make the Earth warmer. Now the seasons have shifted, and the skies are stormier.

So that's why when we stay at home, Viruses see they're all alone. Then maybe they go back to outer space And it's playtime again for the human race.


